## **Market Operator hosted an information webinar on the credit system within EVOZED**

**OTE, a.s. held an online webinar for market participants on Wednesday, 13 May 2026. The purpose of the webinar was to summarise key information on the upcoming credit system within the Evidence of Fulfilment of the Use of Renewable Energy Sources in Transport (EVOZED), present the possibilities for participant testing before the system is launched, and provide space for questions. The webinar was attended by more than 170 participants.**

Participants were introduced to the legislative framework of the credit system, its core principles, and the conditions for issuing credits based on the amount of renewable electricity supplied to electric vehicles at charging stations. The webinar also explained how credits can be transferred and how obligated entities may use them to meet greenhouse gas emission reduction requirements for fuels.

The webinar also outlined the role of the market operator in operating the EVOZED system, the conditions for accessing the system and the basic categories of entities that may hold an account in the system. Participants were also informed about the planned structure of fees for the use of the system and the expected monthly invoicing process.

The webinar included a demonstration of the upcoming module in the market operator's information system, covering the registration of charging stations, submission of monthly reports, credit issuance requests, credit transfers, and their subsequent use by obligated entities. Selected system screens were shown, with the note that their appearance may still change during further testing.

Information was provided on participant testing of new functionalities in the OTE testing environment, including the testing schedule, participation requirements, necessary contractual documentation, and access credentials, such as qualified certificates.

Participants were also informed about the expected system launch procedure, which depends on the publication of the relevant decree, as well as the process for concluding access agreements to EVOZED. Questions from market participants were addressed throughout the webinar.

*OTE, a.s., holds a license for market operator activities, which includes the electricity and gas market in the Czech Republic. A Nominated Electricity Market Organizer (NEMO) is established by the Energy Regulatory Office, which ensures a unified connection of the day and intraday markets. It acts as the National Administrator of the Permit Trading Register.*

*As a market operator and nominated organizer of the electricity market, OTE ensures, among other things, the organization of trading on the daily, intraday electricity market and the intraday gas market in the Czech Republic, and in this activity participates in the organization of the unified EU electricity market. It performs accounting and financial settlement of imbalances between the contractual and actual values of electricity and gas supplies and withdrawals and ensures the administrative change of the supplier of both commodities. It also provides the participants of the electricity and gas market in the Czech Republic with continuous processing and exchange of data and documents for their activities on the electricity market and the gas market, and reports business data from short-term OTE markets to the database of the Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Authorities (ACER).*

*In the name of the Czech Republic and on its account, it supplies settlement entities or takes gas from them when receiving or providing international aid in the gas industry. It administers and pays out compensation payments according to the Act on Measures for the Czech Republic's Transition to Low-Carbon Energy.*

*It is responsible for the administration of the system for the payment of support for supported energy sources. It issues and registers guarantees of the origin of energy and keeps records of the implementation of the use of renewable resources in transport. It ensures many other activities contributing to the development of the energy sector in the Czech Republic and Europe.*
