

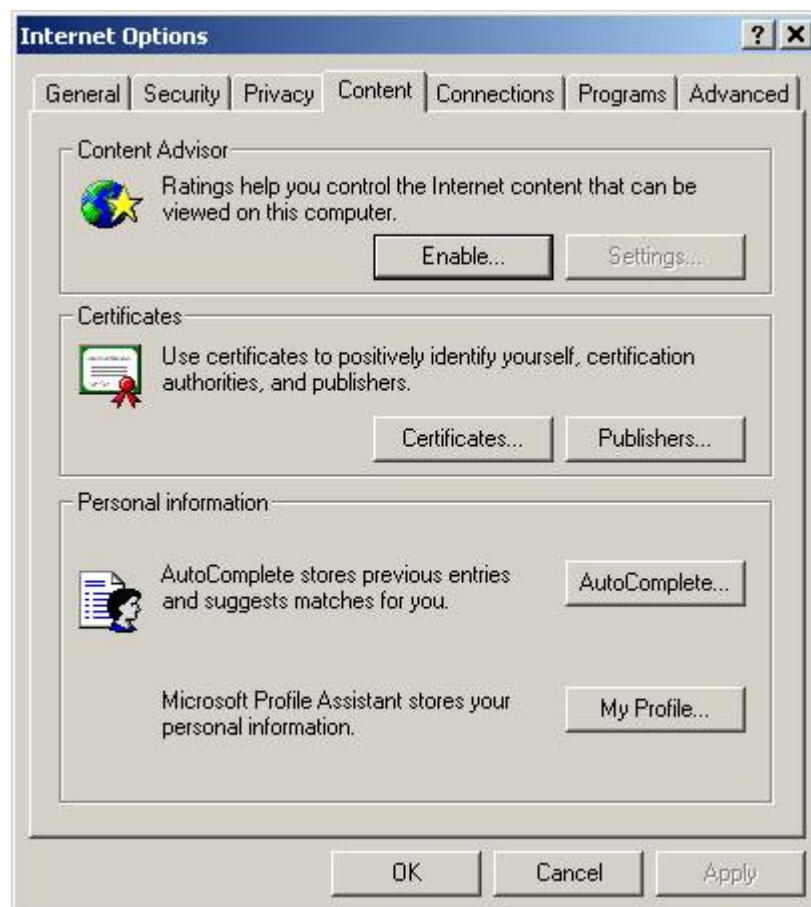
Verification procedure of certificate expiration

This document aims for description of verification procedure of certificate expiration that will be used by common users equipped by a USB token or a GemPLUS reader working with a Smart Card.

Elemental precondition: both a Smart Card and a USB token have a certificate installed in its system.

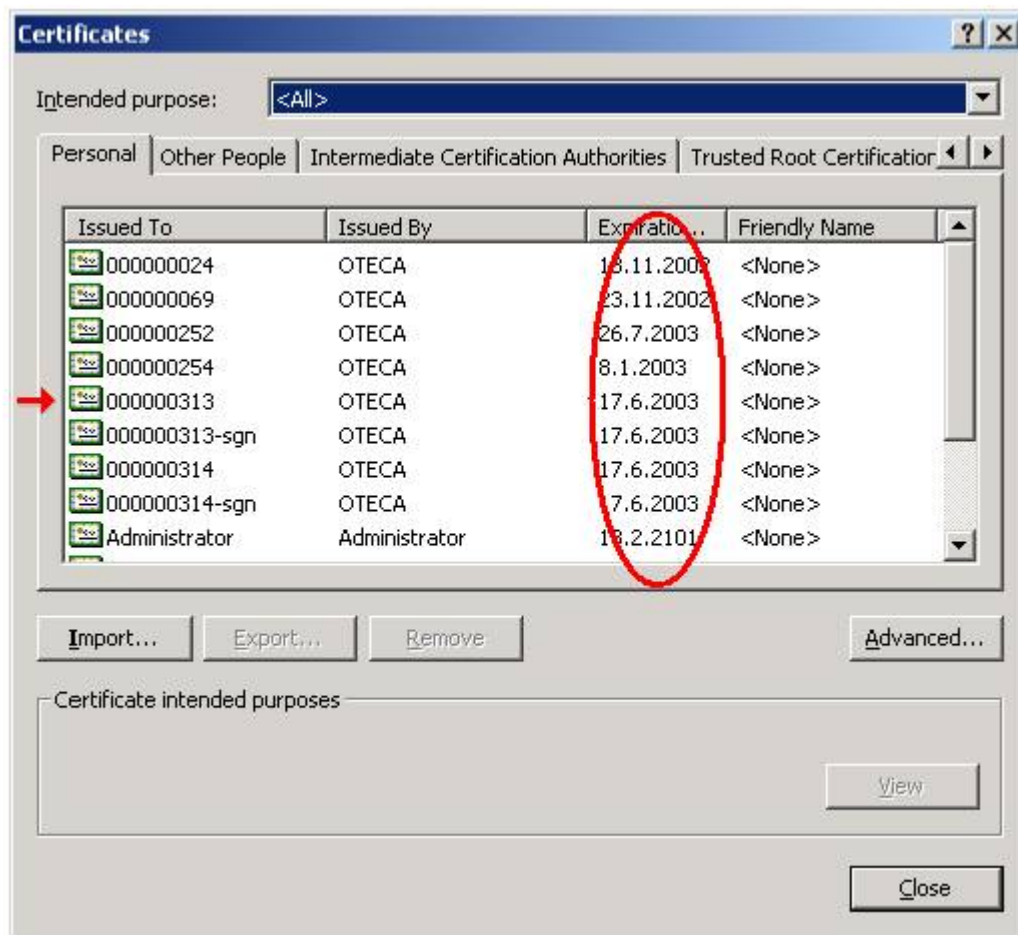
The procedure consists of successive steps:

1. We start MS Internet Explorer version 5.5 SP2 (possibly MS Internet Explorer version 6) – hereafter MSIE - on a running PC with operational system MS Windows 2000.
2. From the option menu we gradually choose items: Tools - Internet Options
3. Dialog windows are opened with tabs containing actual MSIE setting of the access to Internet and security rules.
4. We choose the tab Content.



5. We click the button Certificates in this tab and after that the Windows with the list of all certificates located in a transparent table will be opened. This table contains the column „Expiration Date“ as well. This column states till when the separate certificates are valid.

This picture represents the Certificates Windows in English version with a list of certificates that are installed in the system.



This picture represents the same Windows in Czech version but without installed certificates. We can see separate columns of a list of certificates but in Czech localization.
